RULES FOR HOUSEHOLD WASTER AND RECYCLABLE MATTERS COLLECTION

- Place household waste in black bins. Loose wastes and bags will not be collected.
- Place recyclable matters (and only these) in green bins. If the quantity exceeds bin's capacity, insert recyclable matters in an easy to handle and recyclable box or bag and place it next to your bin. Bins and bags containing non-recyclable matters will not be emptied.
- Bins must be taken to the road the day before the collection. Align bins with the WHEELS and HANDLES facing the HOUSE.
- During winter season, bins must be clear of snow, ice and easily accessible. Otherwise, they may not be emptied.
